


**INQUEST TOUCHING THE DEATH OF**


**LISA SHORE**

I, DR. CATRE, of the City of Toronto in the Province of Ontario, MAKE OATH AND SAY:

1. As indicated during my live testimony at the inquest on November 9, 1999, I was conducting rounds on the morning of October 22, 1998 and was one of the team members who discovered Lisa Shore with no vital signs. (I was one of the senior residents of orthopedic surgery at the time.)
2. I have been asked whether any alarms sounded when the leads were removed from the chest of Lisa Shore, when we commenced compressions as part of our resuscitation efforts.
3. I do not recall that any alarms sounded. I expect that I would recall if an alarm had gone off, given the alarm's loud sound. Accordingly, it is my best recollection that no alarm sounded.
