CLINICAL HISTORY: Fracture of tibia. ? RSD.

The delayed images demonstrate an oblique area of increased activity in the distal right tibia which would be in keeping with a healing spiral fracture. There are also areas of increased activity within the right ankle and right foot which would be in keeping with reactive changes from the injury. The appearance is not consistent with a reflex sympathetic dystrophy.

The blood pool images demonstrate hyperemia in the same regions discussed above.

OPINION:

The findings are consistent with the history of recent trauma. It is unlikely that this reflects reflex sympathetic dystrophy.
